# OFFICIAL NOTICE

To: **Occupant**

Re: **Encampment at Gilman Street Overpass, Berkeley, CA**

This is to advise the occupants of the encampment at the Gilman Street Overpass that the Notice to Abate a Public Nuisance pursuant to Section 11.40.040 Berkeley Municipal Code (BMC) by removing accumulations, such as personal belongings, by July 15, 2014, has been terminated.

This action is based on reports by the East Bay Community Law Center that the occupants are actively working with numerous city agencies to find housing. This action will allow occupants additional time to make relocation arrangements.

The camp activity and accumulations continue to contribute to rodent harborage and create a public nuisance. The City will monitor the situation and may without further notice take appropriate action to abate public nuisance conditions, up to and including the removal of personal property pursuant to Chapter 11.40 BMC.
