# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## Why does it matter where I get counted?

The Census is America's headcount which occurs only once per decade. People must be counted where they usually live, otherwise resources and representation will not be distributed equitably. Understandably, COVID-19 caused many people to move and unfortunately the quarantine began right as Census 2020 was getting started. Currently, neighborhoods around UC Berkeley are among the **LOWEST** responding tracts in the entire nation! In order to prevent the Berkeley community from losing its fair share of funding and representation for the next decade - we need **YOU, YOUR ROOMMATES** and **YOUR FRIENDS** to get counted at their Berkeley addresses. It only takes 10 minutes and is easy to do while sheltered-in-place. When you respond - everyone benefits! [www.my2020census.gov](http://www.my2020census.gov)

## What do I do if I was counted in the wrong place?

Not to worry, just head back to [www.my2020census.gov](http://www.my2020census.gov) and make sure to fill out the Census for the correct address. It only takes ten minutes! You should also check with your roommates to make sure you all got counted at the same address!

## I'm an international student.... do I still need to fill it out?

Yes! The US Constitution requires that every person living in the US is counted in every Census. You are a member of our community so please get counted! The Census site does not function outside the US, so please call 844-330-2020 or have your stateside roommates complete the form for you.

## Is my Census data safe?

The Census Bureau is required by law to protect any personal information collected and to keep it strictly confidential. The Census Bureau can only use your answers to produce statistics. Your answers cannot be used for law enforcement purposes or to determine your personal eligibility for government benefits.

## What if I don't have my Census ID Number (see image below)

Not to worry! You can still fill out the Census, just make sure to click the button that says "If you do not have a Census ID, Click here" on the home screen.
